Before Coming to SLU

VISIT SLU'S CAMPUS

- Go to slu.edu/visit or call **800-SLU-FOR-U** to schedule a walking tour. If you're interested, a visit assistant will also schedule a meeting with our military program director.

APPLY FOR ADMISSION TO SLU

- Review majors and programs you're interested in and their admission criteria.
- Complete SLU's online application at slu.edu/apply.

SEND IN YOUR TRANSCRIPT(S)

- An official high school transcript is required, ACT or SAT score are optional and official test scores are optional.
- Request official military transcripts from your branch of service:
 - For Army, Navy, Marines and Coast Guard, visit jst.doded.mil.
 - For Air Force, visit au.af.mil/au/ccaf.
- Transfer students should visit slu.edu/transfer for more information.
- Send your transcripts to the Office of Admission. Questions? Call **800-SLU-FOR-U**.

SUBMIT A FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID

- If you wish to be considered for need-based financial aid, file your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) between Oct. 1 and Feb. 1.
- Apply online at studentaid.gov with school code 002506.
- Remember to complete the FAFSA application annually.

SELECT YOUR VETERAN EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS

- Apply for benefits online atvets.gov/education/apply/.
- Send your DD Form 214 to Leonard Dollenga, VA certifying official.

RESEARCH ADDITIONAL COLLEGE FINANCING OPTIONS

- By applying for admission to SLU, you're automatically considered for a range of merit-based scholarships. To ensure priority consideration, you should submit all required parts of your application by Dec. 1.
- SLU also offers scholarships that require separate applications — the Presidential Scholarship, the Martin Luther King Jr. Scholarship and the John Paul Fechter Service Scholarship. To see if you qualify, visit slu.edu/admission.
