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Dear colleagues,

The University Undergraduate Core Committee has been hard at work setting up the Core subcommittee review structure through which instructors will submit courses and experiences to count for SLU's new University Core.

To submit an Ignite Seminar for inclusion in either our Core Pilot semester (Fall 2021) or our launch year (2022-23), please visit the [Ignite Seminar pages on the SLU University Core Faculty Development website](#). Deadline for submission is November 25th, 2020.

To submit all other courses or experiences for approval into SLU's University Core, instructors will be asked to complete a worksheet that aligns their course with the Core component-level and University Core-level student learning outcomes associated with that Core area. These worksheets will then be uploaded, along with course information and a complete syllabus, to the new Courseleaf Curriculum Management System (CIM) for review by the UUC. The Courseleaf Core course submission system will open no later than January 4, 2021, with ongoing Faculty and staff training beginning in January 2021.

In the meantime, Instructors interested in submitting Core courses and experiences in the Core component areas below are invited to begin by reviewing the worksheets, [which are available under the "Instructor Resources" tab on the University Core Faculty Development website](#).
