

SLU EXP Scholarship & Redemption Guidelines

How Much Can I Earn in EXP Scholarships at SLU?

A maximum amount of \$6,000 in EXP Scholarships can be earned. EXP Scholarship funds can then be used to reduce your tuition for <u>select Global Graduate Programs at SLU</u>. Note that EXP Scholarships may only be redeemed when you are officially enrolled in one of these select graduate programs. *Regardless of when any EXP Scholarship is earned (see below), the Scholarship cannot be redeemed for any undergraduate level program at SLU*.

When Can I Earn EXP Scholarships?

Portions of that \$6,000 maximum can be earned at multiple stages on your educational path – starting as early as high school, and through your second term as graduate student at SLU. *However:*Regardless of the stage during which the EXP Scholarship money was earned, the maximum amount that can be earned – in total – is \$6,000.

How Much EXP Scholarship Money Can I Earn	Maximum
Prior to enrollment in an eligible SLU Global Graduate program (including while in high school or beyond)	\$4,000
While a graduate student at SLU in the first or second term of enrollment in an eligible Global Graduate program	\$2000
Maximum Scholarship Amount That Can Be Earned Via EXP	\$6,000

Examples of how different students could earn the maximum \$6,000 total at various stages of their educational paths:

	Student A	Student B	Student C
Earned while in High School	4,000	\$2000	\$0
Earned while an undergraduate (at SLU or elsewhere) earning a bachelor's degree	\$0	\$2,000	\$4000
Earned while a graduate student at SLU in the first or second term of enrollment in an eligible Global Graduate program	\$2,000	\$2,000	\$2000
Total Earned (MAX \$6,000)	\$6,000	\$6,000	\$6,000

When Can I Redeem my EXP Scholarships?

EXP Scholarship funds can only be used to reduce your tuition for <u>select Global Graduate Programs at SLU</u>. Accordingly, EXP Scholarships can only be redeemed when you are officially enrolled in one of these select graduate programs – and only in the terms indicated in the table below:

When Can I Redeem My EXP Scholarship Money at SLU?	First Term of Graduate Program	Second Term of Graduate Program	Third Term of Graduate Program	Fourth Term of Graduate Program
Eligible One-Year Global Graduate Programs	n/a	100% of Total Earned	n/a	n/a
Eligible Two-Year Global Graduate Programs	n/a	n/a	50% of Total Earned	50% of Total Earned

Additionally:

- SLU EXP scholarships hold no cash value; the scholarship amount(s) will be credited against the
 tuition charged by SLU for the eligible Global Graduate program in which you enroll, and per the
 table above.
- For seamless redemption of any earned EXP Scholarship, please take the following steps:
 - Log in to your Excelerate account.
 - Navigate to the "Personal Information" section.
 - Under the "Contact Info" section, locate the "Alternate Email ID" field.
 - Add your SLU email ID as your alternate email ID.
 - Even if the primary email address in your account is your SLU Email ID, make sure you also add it in the alternate Email ID section.
 - o If you have created multiple accounts on Excelerate, please note that you can only add your SLU Email ID to one account. You cannot combine scholarships from multiple accounts. If you do add your SLU Email ID to multiple accounts, the account with the lower scholarship value will be considered for redemption.
- Any EXP Scholarship money earned while studying via INTO in a Graduate Pathway will count
 only toward the \$4,000 maximum students may earn prior to official enrollment in an eligible
 Global Graduate program.
 - O SLU EXP scholarships can be redeemed against tuition in the eligible Global Graduate program, not against tuition or fees in the Graduate Pathway.
 - Completion of a minimum of two semesters at SLU (inclusive of Graduate Pathway semesters) plus matriculation to SLU is required.

- O Academic English only semesters are excluded from the minimum semester requirement mentioned above
