Continuation Standards: Students must have a minimum of a $2.0\ \mathrm{average}\ \mathrm{GPA}$ in their major-related courses. Students who fall below a 2.0 average in major-related courses will be placed on probation. If the student fails to obtain at least a 2.0 average GPA in major-related courses after two consecutive semesters on probation, the student will not be allowed to continue in the program.

To be certified for graduation, a student is required to...

- Complete no less than 120 credits, including 37 cr. in the ARTH major;
- Have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA, a 2.0 ARTH GPA, and a 2.0 GPA in the minor or 2nd major;
- Complete 30 of the final 36 cr. at SLU;
- Submit the on-line application for graduation at the beginning of the last semester of study.
