To be certified for graduation, a student is required to...

- Complete no less than 120 credits, including 39 credits in the CMM major;
- Have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA, a 2.0 CMM GPA, and a 2.0 GPA in the minor or 2<sup>nd</sup> major;
- Complete 30 of the final 36 cr. at SLU; 3.
- Submit the on-line application for graduation at the beginning of the last semester of study.
