A grade of "C or better is required in every course counting for the MLIC major.

Only 6 credits of language courses can be transferred into the MLIC major.

To be certified for graduation, a student is required to...

1. Complete no less than 120 credits, including 32 cr. in the MLIC major;
2. Have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA, a 2.0 MLIC GPA, and a 2.0 GPA in the minor or 2nd major;
3. Complete 30 of the final 36 cr. at SLU;
4. Submit the on-line application for graduation at the beginning of the last semester of study.
