Registering for CITI Human Subjects Research Training

Affiliating with SLU Quicksheet

1	Log into your account at http://www.citiprogram.org .	?
2	Click the link “Add Institutional Affiliation” to start the affiliation process.	?
3	Search for (by beginning to type) “Saint Louis University”. Type “Saint” not “St.”. Click both checkboxes to agree to Terms of Service and affirm affiliation.	?
4	Complete your SLU learner profile. Include your Banner ID # and modified SLU email address to ensure the link between training records and the eIRB system.	?
5	Under the Saint Louis University Courses menu, select “Add a Course”.	?
6	Select a training course (IRB mandated training is first option).	?
7	Select “NO” (you haven’t taken the basic course) unless you are sure a previous basic HSR course has been accepted by the SLU IRB for your account. The refresher course will not satisfy the training requirement on its own.	?
8	Select the version of the course you want (BIO/BSS/External Collaborator). Note that the External Collaborator course is not for SLU faculty, staff or students or for anyone who is routinely conducting research.	?
9	Your course is located under the Saint Louis University “Courses Ready to Begin” menu.	?

LIST YOUR SLU NetID + @slu.edu. THIS IS THE ONLY WAY THE IRB WILL HAVE RECORD OF YOUR TRAINING. Your SLU NetID is the username you use to log into MySLU or a SLU computer. Example: I log into my SLU computer/myslu with smithr. In this box, put smithr@slu.edu even if you have an @health.slu.edu address. If you don't go to or work at SLU, you can enter any email address.

To enable the software to present the appropriate course work for your needs, you will be asked a series of questions. Please read the questions carefully and provide the most appropriate answer.

Do you conduct research in any the following settings?

This question is required. Choose all that apply.

- Yes, I need to take **required IRB Training**.** I conduct research with live human beings, human tissue samples or with data derived from human beings
- Yes, I need to take **IACUC Training**.** I conduct research or teaching activities that utilizes **live animal subjects** or tissues derived from live animal subjects
- Yes, I want to complete or I am required to complete a course in the **Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR)**.** This course features foundation textual materials, case studies and video scenarios. This does not include or count toward required IRB training.
- Yes, I want to or am required to take the **Good Clinical Practice (GCP)** course.** This course is required for NIH funded Clinical Trial personnel, and some sponsors, but is otherwise optional. This does not fulfill the requirement for IRB training
- Yes, I need to take the **Conflict of Interest (COI)** Course.** I am involved in externally-sponsored research or I plan to submit an application for external funding. The COI Course does not fulfill the requirement for IRB training

STEP 6:


In order to place you in the appropriate course we need to know if you have previously completed the Basic Course in the Protection of Human Research Subjects.

Question 3

If you conduct Human Subjects Research, what is your research focus?

This question is required. Choose one answer.

- I conduct Biomedical Research. This is the **first time** I will take the CITI basic course for investigators and key personnel at Saint Louis University.
- I conduct Social / Behavioral Research: This is the **first time** I will take the CITI basic course for investigators and key personnel at Saint Louis University.
- I am an external collaborator (e.g., community partner). I am assisting on a Saint Louis University research project and have been instructed to take this course.

NOTE: this course is not for SLU faculty, staff or students or for anyone who is routinely conducting research.

Biomedical Research: Individuals who conduct *any* biomedical research should select this course during registration.

Social/Behavioral Research: Individuals who conduct *only* social/behavioral research should select this course during registration.

External Collaborator: This course is only for non-SLU collaborators, such as community partners (not SLU faculty, staff or students), who are assisting on a SLU research project and have been instructed to take this course. Those who routinely partner on SLU research should select either the Biomedical or Social/Behavioral Research basic courses instead of this course.
